

Report on Visit to Birla Planetarium

The Students of the Department of Mathematics, as a part of their Extension Activity (Educational Trip) program, paid a visit to **B. M. Birla Planetarium** (Periyar Science and Technology Centre), on 13/04/2022 (Wednesday) at Kotturpuram, Chennai. **22 Students** of the Department accompanied by 4 Staff Members namely **Dr. R. Kokila, Head, Department of Mathematics, Mrs. K. Mohana Devi, Mrs. B. Mohana Priya, Mr. G. Gokul Vijay** visited the Birla Planetarium at about 11.00 am.

**B. M. Birla Planetarium** is a large planetarium in Chennai providing a virtual tour of the night sky and holding cosmic shows on a specially perforated hemispherical aluminium inner dome. The fifth in the country, B. M. Birla planetarium is located at Kotturpuram in the Periyar Science and Technology Centre campus which houses eight galleries, namely, Physical Science, Electronics and Communication, Energy, Life Science, Innovation, Transport, International Dolls and Children & Materials Science, with over 500 exhibits.

Our students watched the 5D shows related to the solar system, sky, comets, and different types of stars around 12 noon. They gained knowledge about how the solar system moves, the study of seasons and comets, the cause for seasons, the expenditure of Man on the moon and planets. They also watched 3D shows related to Aluadeen history.

The students later on visited the Math lab atomic energy museum, Missiles, Satellites, Shake pendulum, World clock virtual harp, Ocean gallery, Locomotive boiler, determining the Age of tree, calculation of Muscles power, the working of battery, Progress of India in Space (different types of satellites), Visualizing sound, Infinity well, Infinity train moving rows, Transport gallery, Four cylinder engine, Left right conflicts. In the Maths lab, the students also explored a variety of games and formulae which are related to Mathematics Tricks. And also visited earth on a sphere. The students also gained information about the weather conditions of places, the cyclone and temperature variations, ozone layer depletion and increase in the earth atmospheric temperature.

Overall this educational trip was very informative to our students and staff.
