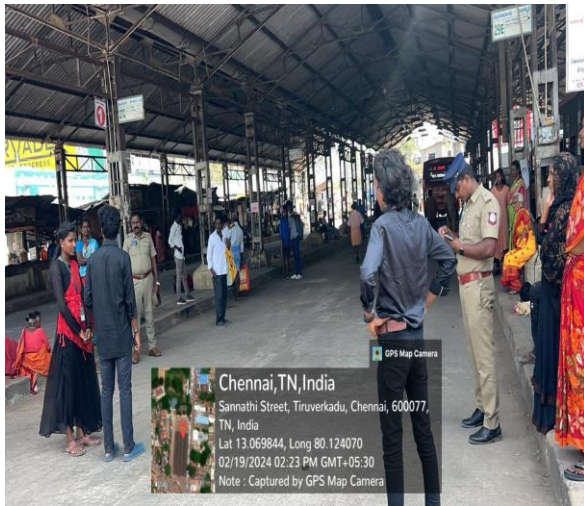




## NASHA MUKT BHARATH ABHIYAN (NMBA)

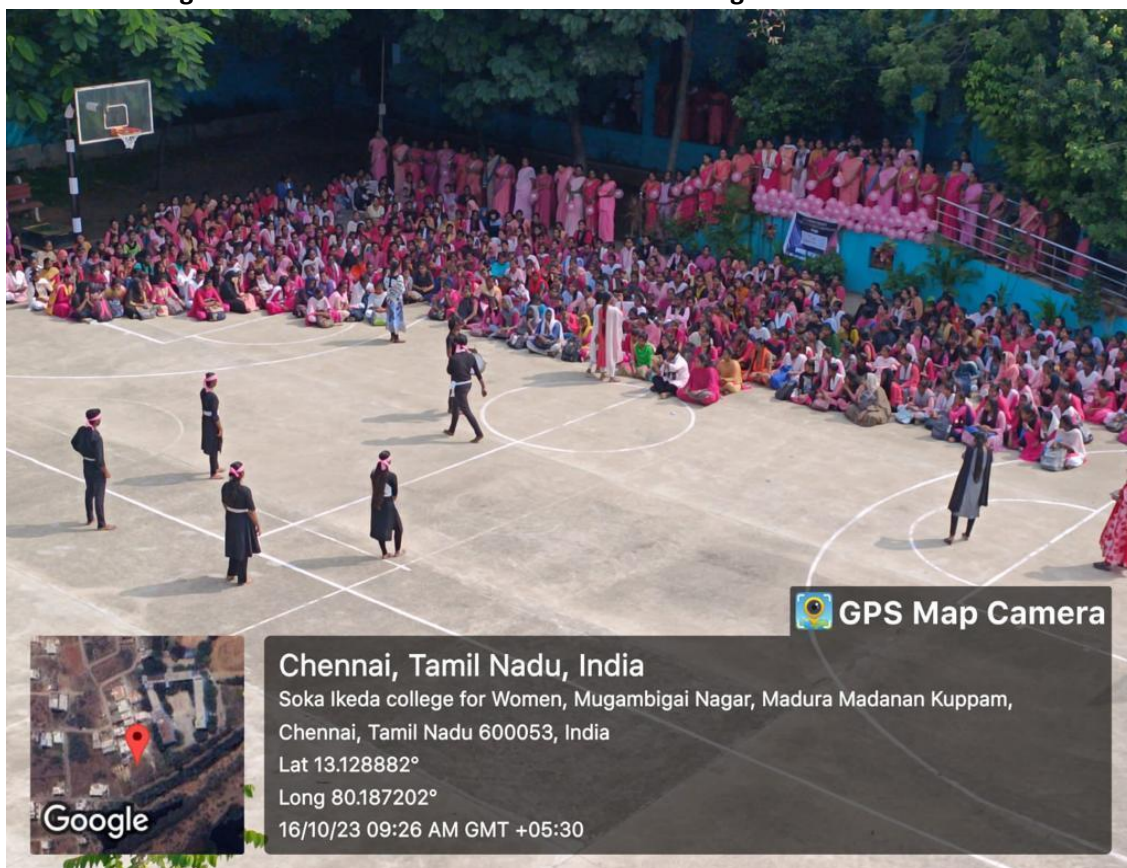

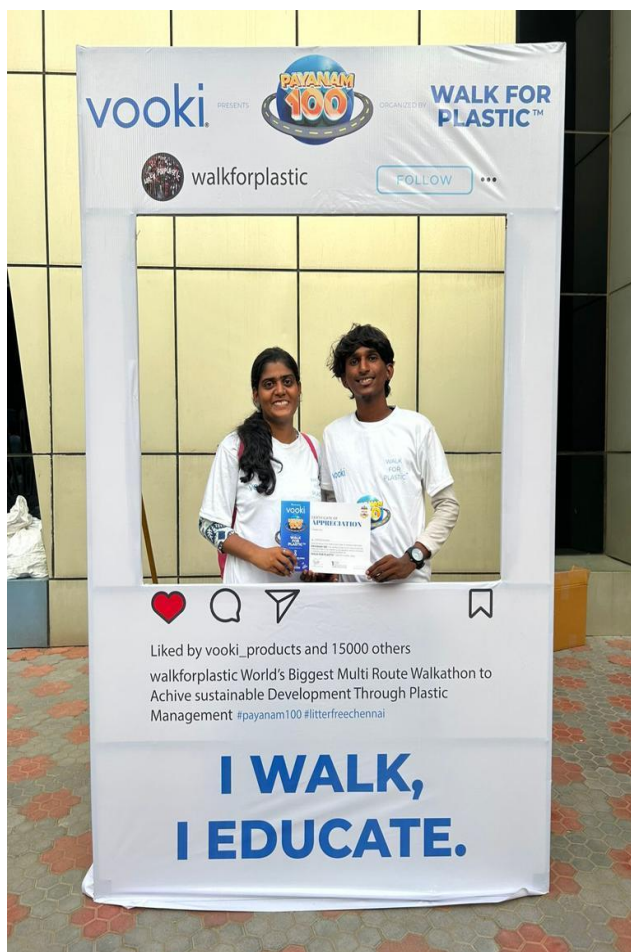
